The Project

The leading provider of risk management solutions to defined benefit pension funds, Pension Corporation, took 2 floors of the newly refurbished **14 Cornhill**, equating to 24,000 sq ft having moved out of Almack House in King Street, W1. The project included one floor devoted to meeting rooms and offices fitted out to a high specification, including boardrooms with video conferencing installation, and food and beverage preparation facilities.

Client Objectives

Create a meeting facility consistent with the heightened market profile that the company now enjoyed. Install a future proofed power and data solution throughout the open plan area that ensured future churn and growth could be managed easily. Control the project budget as there were a number of key items that had not been finalised when the contractor first went on site due to the time pressures the Client was facing.
